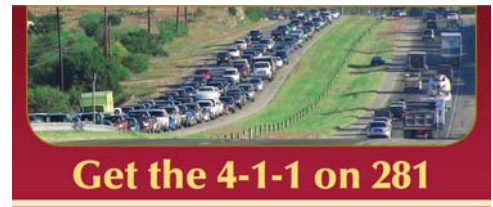

**Construction schedule for the Alamo RMA US 281 Super Street
Weather permitting; the following construction closures will take place.
For the week of: Sunday, July 18, 2010 - Thursday, July 22, 2010**

Encino Rio

Crews continue to widen the center median of West bound Encino Rio which will require the closure of the left lane between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. each day.

Intersection of 281 North and Evans Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Turnarounds at this intersection are almost complete with the exception of final surfacing and signalization work to be completed within the month of August.

US 281 and Stone Oak

Crews will widen the center median of US 281 north and south bound of Stone Oak. The inside lane of US 281 will be closed between 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews continue Concrete rail work on the u-turns north and south of Marshall will continue during the day from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and will not affect traffic.

Previous Activity for week of July 11, 2010

The contractor continued operations for placement of electrical conduit; installation of traffic poles; widening of u-turn areas.

The Alamo RMA apologies for any delays encountered in this phase of construction and suggest you might adjust your travel plan to avoid these lane closures when possible.
