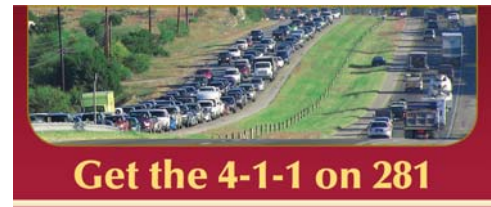

Construction closures scheduled for the Alamo RMA US 281 Super Street

Weather permitting; the following construction closures will take place.

The Alamo RMA apologizes for any delays encountered in this phase of construction and suggests that you please adjust your travel plan to avoid these lane closures when possible.

For the period of - Sunday – Thursday, June 27, 2010 – July 1, 2010

Intersection of 281 North and Evans Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will continue boring operations for placement of electrical conduit and work on installation of new traffic signals anytime between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Both Northbound and Southbound lanes will remain open. **Crews will begin widening the roadway in the center median for the u-turns both north and south of Evans. The inside lane and possibly the inside two lanes, in each direction, will be closed between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. daily.**

Intersection of 281 North and Encino Rio (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will continue to place concrete rails at the u-turns south of Encino Rio between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM. **Crews will continue to widen the roadway in the center median for the u-turns both north and south of Encino Rio. The inside and possibly the two inside lanes, in each direction, will be closed between the hours of 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. daily.**

Intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will close the northbound and southbound right lane at the intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. excavating the rock face. No lane closures at night are anticipated for this week.
