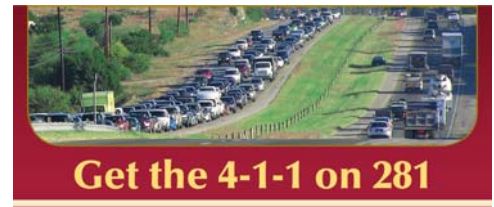

Construction closures scheduled next week for the 281 Super Street

Weather permitting; the following construction closures will take place.

Sunday – Thursday, April 18-22, 2010

Intersection of 281 North and Evans Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will work on new traffic signals anytime between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Lanes will remain open.

Intersection of 281 North and Encino Rio (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will close the northbound and southbound left lanes at the intersection of 281 North and Encino Rio from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. widening the center median.

Intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will close the northbound and southbound right lane at the intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. excavating the rock face.
