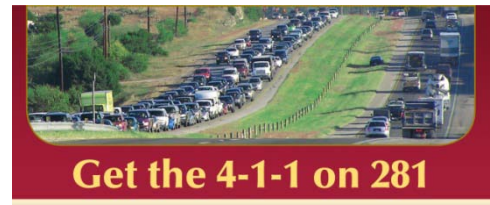

Alamo RMA US 281 Super Street Update **Please use caution when driving US 281 North –**

Due to Tropical Storm Hermine a number of intersections along US 281 are experiencing problems at this time. Crews are en route to correct these problems.

Intersection of 281 North at Encino Rio and Evans **(Northbound and Southbound lanes)**

Due to Tropical Storm Hermine, signals at Encino Rio and Evans are on flashing red. Crews are immediately responding to reset the signals.

We encourage drivers to take another route and stay off US 281, until the signals have been reset. If driving on US 281 is absolutely necessary please use caution and expect traffic delays.

Intersection of 281 North at Stone Oak Parkway / TPC Parkway

Due to heavy winds, the traffic signals on the approaches to US 281 have been damaged and will need to be replaced at this intersection.

The Alamo RMA and City of San Antonio are working together to immediately restore signals in this intersection

Drivers can expect lengthy delays while these emergency repairs are made. Traffic control officers will be on the US 281 corridor during this time to assist with traffic operations. Please exercise caution when driving along US 281 during this time.

Construction has been cancelled on the US 281 Super Street for the next several days due to Tropical Storm Hermine.
