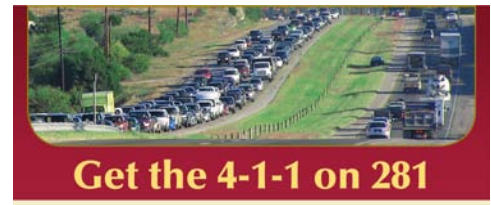

## **Construction closures scheduled next week for the Alamo RMA 281 Super Street Project, weather permitting:**

**For the period of - Sunday – Thursday, May 30 – June 4, 2010**

**Note: In observance of Memorial Day, no construction work will take place on Sunday night through Monday evening. Work will commence Monday night at 9:30 p.m.**

### Intersection of 281 North and Evans Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will continue boring operations for placement of electrical conduit and work on installation of new traffic signal poles anytime between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Both Northbound and Southbound lanes will remain open. Crews will also begin widening the roadway on the outside for the u-turn on the Northbound lane between the hours of 9:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

### Intersection of 281 North and Encino Rio (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will continue drilling the signal foundations in the center median between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Both Northbound and Southbound left lanes at the intersection of 281 North will be closed from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for roadway widening work which includes asphalt placement.

### Intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road (Northbound and Southbound lanes)

Crews will continue to pour concrete rail between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Crews will close the northbound and southbound right lane at the intersection of 281 North and Marshall Road from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. excavating the rock face.

### Previous Week Activity May 23-28, 2010

*The contractor continued boring operations for placement of electrical conduit; installation of traffic poles; widening of u-turn areas and began pouring concrete for traffic rails in the areas excavated.*
